1.	04 Oct 2009	Gourahari Patra	Jharsuguda	Due to erratic rainfall and swarming caterpillar His rice cultivation has been totally damaged , he anticipated that he is unable to repay the loan amounts of thirty thousand
2.	7 Oct, 2009	Bidyadhar Bag, 50	Sambalpur	His paddy crop was badly affected by pests.
3.	10 Oct, 2009	Dillip Das, 28	Balesore	Unable to bear the burden of Rs 10,000 and Rs 23,305 loan
4.	18th October 09	Angad Barik, 65	Sambalpur	Due to poor rainfall he sustained heavy crop loss. He had taken a cooperative loan of Rs 25,000 in the name of his son. "Financial burden and being affected by a mysterious disease crippled him mentally.
5.	20 October 09	Amarendra Pradhan , 40	Jharsuguda	Huge loss this year due to poor rainfall.
6.	22 October 09	Sunil Sutar, 44	Nawarangpur	Due to crop loss & more than 40000 loan
7.	October 25, 2009	Banchhanidhi Pradhan, 60	Ganjam	Debt ridden and had lost his crop owing to cater pillar and drought like situation.
8.	October 28, 2009	Kusha Dhawaja Majhi	Nuapada	Case of poverty and large amount of loan from fellow villagers.
9.	October 29, 2009	Mahasai Narang, 60	Sundargarh	Due to crop loss
10.	1 st November 09	Kartika Mahakuda, 60	Sonepur	Due to crop loss
11.	5 th November 09	Baladeb barik , 35	Balangir	scanty rainfall and caterpillar attack five acres of his cultivated agricultural land
12.	5 th November 09	Dhanu munda champia, 42	Cuttack	Due to crop loss, Pest attack in paddy field
13.	5 th November 09	P. Srinibas Rao, 40	Jaypur	Due to crop loan 1 lakh 1 lakh thousand & crop loss
14.	5 th November 09	Ugrasen Mahanandia, 41	Baoud	34 thousand loan

15.	7 th November 2009	Diver Hembram, 55	Mayurbhanj	Due to debt & problem in their farming
16.	12 th Nov 2009	Debraj Jena, 35	Dhenkanal	Due to loan of about Rs 76,000, including Rs 18,000 from a local cooperative society.
17.	12 th Nov 2009	Sahadev Jena, 34	Dhenkanal	due to crop loss and his inability to repay loans
18.	13 th November 09	Durlabh Bagarti, 42	Bargarh	Due to his brinjal crop was completely destroyed in pest attack. Bagarti had taken a loan of nearly Rs 1 lakh from a bank and micro-finance society and had defaulted on repayment.
19.	13 th November 09	Francis Kujur, 35	Sundargarh	Could not pay off the loan out of the earnings from his cultivation. The loan burden of Rs 45,000
20.	14 th November 09	Jhasaketana Bhoi, 38	Bargarh	Due to crop loss & 5 lakh loan
21.	14 th November 09	Baikuntha Bhoi, 64	Bargarh	His crops were ruined by pest attack and he had taken both private and hand loan forcing him to consume poison.
22.	14 th November 09	Sukanta Bagarti	Bargarh	Due to crop loss by chakada poka & loan
23.	14 th November 09	Phakir Patel	Sambalpur	Due to pest attack by leda poka & 3 lakh loan
24.	15 th November 09	Biswambara Jena, 40	Keonjhar	Due to crop loss
25.	15 th November 09	Frabsis Kujura	Sundargarh	Due to debt of 50,000
26.	16 th November 09	Dambaru Rana, 50	Kalahandi	Due to loan burden & crop loss by pest attack.
27.	16 th November 09	Surasingh Sabar, 35	Nuapada	Due to loss his crop and expected no yield from his land. He had borrowed Rs 6000 from a bank and Rs 20000 privately.
28.	16 th November 09	Dhansingh Sabar, 70	Nuapada	Due to his son Surasingh Sabar death. His son is only earned person in his family.

29.	17 th November 09	Maheswar Rohidas, 53	Sambalpur	Due to crop loss & farm debt
30.	17 th November 09	Kartik Rohidas, 53	Sambalpur	Due to attack by caterpillars on his standing crops
31.	20 th November 09	Basanta Nayak, 36	Balesore	Due to debt of 90,000& 80% crop loss
32.	20 th November 09	Krupasindhu Pal, 45	Balesore	Due to debt of 50,000
33.	20 th November 09	Kanhu Hembram, 45	Keonjhar	Due to crop loss
34.	22 nd November 09	Santosh Nayak	Keonjhar	Due to crop loss
35.	22 nd November 09	Narendra Kumar Sahu, 34	Keonjhar	Due to crop loss
36.	26 th November 09	Kesab Sahu, 25	Keonjhar	Due to debt 10,000/- & crop loss
37.	27 th November 09	Mohan Singh, 45	Sundargarh	He had taken a loan from the bank for agriculture and he could not repay the loan amount due to crop failure.
38.	9 th December ,09	Manoranjan Parida, 40	Jagatsinghpur	His paddy crops have been completely damaged in this year due to pest menace in which he was completely harassed.
39.	13 th December 09	Balkrishna Singh, mid-twenties	Sundargarh	The farmer was apprehensive of poor crop yield due to erratic monsoon
